Description:

As the Electrical Engineering Coordinator, you will be responsible for supervising all engineering team members to create an energetic and positive work environment. You will take a hands-on approach to the job and play an active part in development of the wide array of projects we are undertaking at any given time. You will work with your team members, our vendors, customers and occasionally 3rd party partners to set goals, plan projects, build a timeline and stay within budget. You will utilize best practice engineering methods and provide expert technical guidance for engineering initiatives. Your duties will include project management, hiring new team members, meeting with upper-level management to provide project updates and being the voice of engineering in customer meetings.

Responsibilities:

- Analyze all aspects of batteries and battery applications to ensure proper operation
- Develop test plans that will help to understand systems/applications to ensure the proper use of our batteries
- Prioritize projects from the top down while scheduling out daily, weekly and monthly team actions
- Develop hardware and test harnesses to run specialized tests
- Write product specifications for various applications
- Work with OEMs and large accounts to optimize battery designs and/or battery modifications
- Review custom battery requests and determine feasibility of requirements and implementation
- Develop new product schedules from concept to launch
- Test battery charging systems (chargers, DC-DC converters, inverters, and charge controllers)
- Develop hardware and software for specialized tests to duplicate field conditions.
- Develop test specifications and test instructions for new and current products.
- Lead the development of automated test equipment and fixtures for board-level testing and for final-assembly testing.
- Provide support documentation that outline test procedures, test measurements, and troubleshooting steps.
- Provide engineering support to internal and external customers in the areas of applications engineering, system design and product integration.
- Lead successful launch of new products.

Our engineering lab is located in Snohomish, WA. The Engineering Coordinator will spend time working in both the lab with the team and via a home-office. Ideally, candidate will reside in Seattle, WA area, however, we are open for this position to reside outside of Washington State for the right candidate.
